

PRE-CHECKS

WARNING - PLEASE READ SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FIRST!

- Please wear Personal protective Equipment
- Top engine fuel tank up with clean, fresh Petrol
- Ensure tyre pressure is correct in both wheels i.e. 25-30PSI
- Check tow coupler is secured correctly to unit
- Make sure unit is on level ground
- If the unit is not on level ground, ensure the wheels are chocked and secured to prevent any unplanned movement
- Check power lead is safe, has a current EC and is appropriately connected on electric models
- Petrol models check oil
- Check mixer drum is empty



MIXER START UP AND SHUT DOWN

FOR THE ABEL MIXER: ELECTRIC-POWERED MODEL

To Start:

- Ensure no people are in the vicinity of the mixer unit
- Ensure mixer is on level ground and the wheels are chocked
- Ensure the mixer and power lead/s are safe and not on damp or wet surfaces
- Ensure RCD is operable and connected
- Ensure electrical lead is connected and the correct length
- Turn on/off switch to the 'on' position

To Shut Down:

- Ensure the mixer drum is in stowed position (drum facing ground)
- Turn on/off switch to the 'off' position
- If the mixer is no longer to be used, switch off power supply

FOR THE ABEL MIXER: PETROL-POWERED MODEL

To Start:

- Ensure no people are in the vicinity of the mixer unit
- Ensure mixer is on level ground and the wheels are chocked
- Turn the fuel tap on
- Turn choke on
- Pull the recoil rope gently until there is resistance
- Release and pull the recoil rope swiftly to start and then switch off choke
- Increase RPM to applicable range

To Shut Down:

- Ensure the mixer drum is in stowed position (drum facing ground)
- Decrease RPM to idle
- Turn on/off switch to the 'off' position
- Switch off fuel tap

REGULAR CHECKS & OPERATING TIPS

- Overall check of unit and all fasteners
- Check wheels, axle and wheel nuts
- Check tow coupler and trailer plug including lights
- Check tow bar and frame for damage including rear stabiliser bar
- Check bowl and support
- Check crown wheel and bowl gear
- Check engine/electric motor base plate security
- Oil leaks and oil level
- Check electric motor is turning freely and not getting hot
- Check electric test and tag is valid
- Remove rear cover to inspect pulleys and belt re tension if needed
- When in operation, listen for any abnormal noises
- Always use on level ground and good footing
- Never overload unit when operating
- Do not try and stop the drum movement by hand
- Keep all loose clothing clear of rotating equipment
- Do not operate without the covers securely in place
- Do not use the unit with known faults that can cause injury or further damage

WARRANTY PERIOD/S:

- 2-year Manufacturer's Warranty on Build (Defects in material and workmanship)
- 2-year on electric motor
- 3-year Manufacturer's Warranty on HONDA engines (see Honda Owner's Manual and website for details).

Responsibility of the Consumer under this Limited Warranty:

- Mixer to be serviced every six months or 100 hours whichever comes first
- Mixer to be maintained and repaired when required, not to be used with a known fault
- Mixer bowl to be cleaned after use
- Engine maintenance to be carried out to manufacturer's recommendations (proof required)
